Message:

Like John the Baptist, we too can point others to Jesus through our words and deeds.

Bible text: Acts 19: 3–4

And he [Paul] said to them, "Into what then were you baptized?" So they said, "Into John's baptism." Then Paul said, "John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus."

Summary

- Willingness to repent is a virtue of a true follower of Jesus.
- Christian baptism is a gift of God and not a work of human beings. Through this sacrament, the triune God guarantees His nearness to human beings.
- Our words and actions should point to the true Redeemer, Jesus Christ, and provide orientation to others.
