Theme:

Message:

Jesus reveals Himself in words and deeds.

Bible text: John 1: 29–31

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! This is He of whom I said, 'After me comes a Man who is preferred before me, for He was before me.' I did not know Him; but that He should be revealed to Israel, therefore I came baptizing with water."

Summary:

- John's baptism was a baptism of repentance. Christian baptism establishes a believer's first close relationship with Jesus Christ.
- We have been baptized with water and the Spirit. We demonstrate that we belong to Jesus through our conduct.
- When Jesus reveals Himself at His return, His bridal congregation will also be revealed.
